- **Has no education beyond high school**

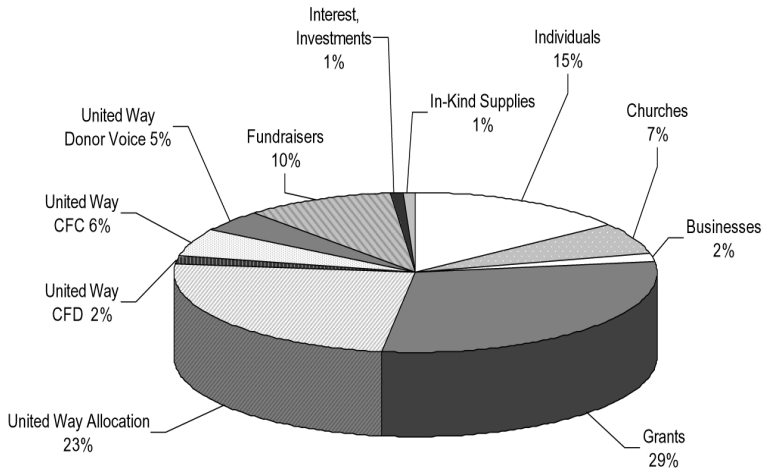

**2010 Neighborhood Clinic** received the **Non Profit Excellence Award** for Impact, an award given to an organization for significant impact on their community.

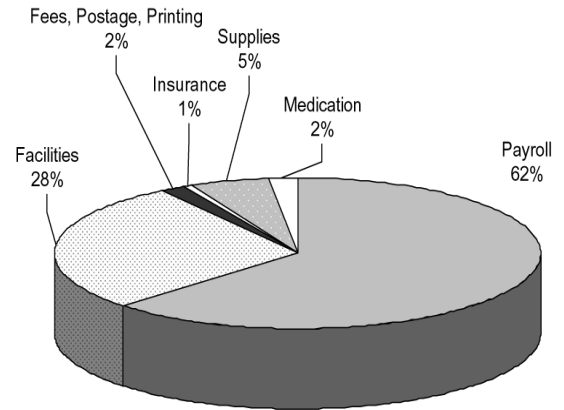
